Angel of God, my guardian dear, to whom His love commits me here; Ever this day be at my side, to light and guard, to rule and guide. Amen!

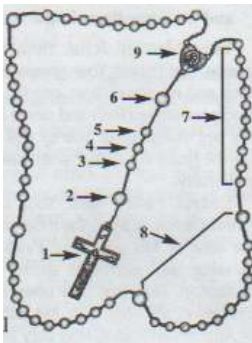

Divine Mercy... This Feast, which had already been granted to the nation of Poland and celebrated within Vatican City, was named by Pope John Paul II on the occasion of the canonization of Sister Maria Faustina on April 30, 2000, and then officially decreed by the Vatican on May 23, 2000. Pope John Paul II described Mercy Sunday: "In a special way, it is the *Sunday of thanksgiving* for all goodness that God has shown us in the whole Easter mystery." On February 22, 1931, Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ appeared to this simple nun, bringing with Him a wonderful message of Mercy for all mankind. Sister Faustina tells us in her diary under this date: "In the evening, when I was in my cell, I became aware of the Lord Jesus clothed in a white garment. One hand was raised in blessing, the other was touching the garment at the breast. From the opening in the garment at the breast there came forth two large rays, one red and the other pale. In silence I gazed intently at the Lord; my soul was overwhelmed with fear, but also with great joy. After a while Jesus said to me: 'Paint an image according to the pattern you see, with the inscription: Jesus, I trust in You!'"

How To Pray The Chaplet of The Divine Mercy



- 1.) Make the Sign of the Cross
- 2.) Say the optional Opening Prayer: You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us. O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fountain of mercy for us, I trust in You!

- 3.) Say the 'Our Father'
- 4.) Say the 'Hail Mary'
- 5.) Say the Apostles' Creed
- 6.) Say the 'Eternal Father' : **Eternal Father**, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

7.) Say 10 '**For the Sake of His** sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and the whole world' on the Hail Mary beads.

8.) Repeat for four more decades, saying '**Eternal Father**..(#6)' on the 'Our Father' bead and then 10 '**For the Sake of His** sorrowful Passion..(#7)' on the following 'Hail Mary' beads.

9.) At the conclusion of the 5 decades, on the medallion say the concluding doxology: '**Holy God**, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world,' three times.

10.) Closing Prayer: **Eternal God**, in whom, mercy is endless, and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon us, and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments, we might not despair, nor become despondent, but with great confidence, submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy Itself. Amen.
