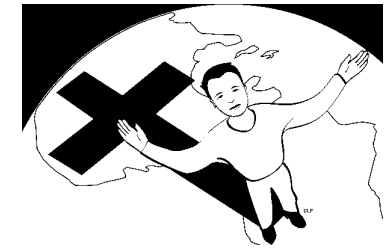

Our History Section In 1934, about 5000 people took part in a pilgrimage from St. Adalbert's to Transfiguration Church commemorating 1900 years since the death of Jesus Christ and also the Holy Year announced by His Holiness Pope Pius XI. When the beginning of the procession arrived at Transfiguration, the back of the procession was still at St. Adalbert's. The mission was celebrated by Fr. Tomaszewski of Bydgoszcz, a member of the Order of Holy Spirit, who was well known in Poland and America.
