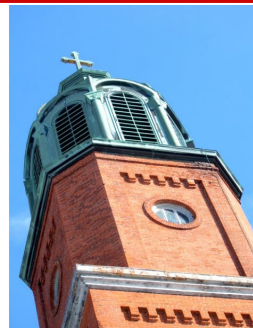

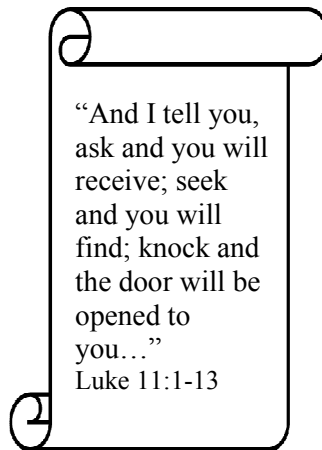

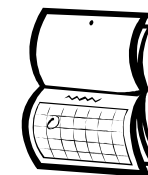

**Our History Corner** In 1886 a group of Polish immigrants applied to the Bishop, Rt. Rev. Stephen Ryan and received his approval to build a church on Stanislaus Street. A small frame building was erected by the parishioners themselves. A tract of land comprised of 27 lots was bought. The church called "A Little Chapel" was used for both church services and a school. The first pastor, Rev. A. Klawiter said Mass on September 12, 1886!
