

Our History Section St. Adalbert's has 7 altars; the High Altar—St. Adalbert; Sacred Heart of Jesus; Holy Mother of the Rosary; Our Lady of Częstochowa; St. Theresa; Our Lady of Perpetual Help; and the Altar of the Patron Saints of Poland in the Jubilee Chapel. Our Main Altar: The massive Main Altar was installed after the death of Rev. Flaczek, who bequeathed funds to cover the cost. The marble statue on the right is of St. Francis of Assisi, Patron Saint of Rev. Francis Kałużny. On the left is St. John the Baptist, Patron Saint of Rev. Kałużny's Father. The statues of St. Adalbert (center) and St. John the Baptist were unveiled in 1934, when Bishop Turner administered the Sacrament of Confirmation to 847 persons at St. Adalbert's. The angels holding the Crown of Poland are 6 feet tall. Take a closer look at this beautiful Altar and see the attention to detail!
