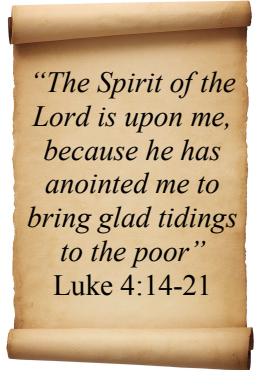

**Ecumenical Sunday—Third Sunday in Ordinary Time** What does Ordinary Time mean? Ordinary time is a season of the Catholic Liturgical Calendar. The English name is intended to translate the Latin term *Tempus Per Annum*, literally meaning *Time Through The Year*. Ordinary Time begins on the day following the Baptism of the Lord, the feast which normally falls on the Sunday after Epiphany and continues until Ash Wednesday, which marks the beginning of the Season of Lent.
