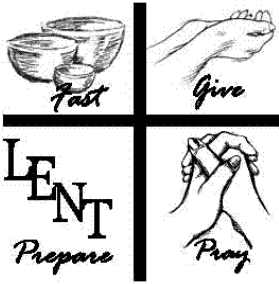

Lent is a time of preparation for the death of Christ on Good Friday and His Resurrection on Easter Sunday. It is a period of 40 days of repentance, with prayer, fasting and abstinence, and Confession. The three traditional pillars of Lenten observance are prayer, fasting and almsgiving. **Abstinence** All Catholics, 14 years of age until death are to abstain from eating meat on Fridays in honor of the Passion of Jesus on Good Friday.

Fasting All Catholics from their 18th Birthday to their 59th Birthday are to reduce the amount of food eaten from normal days. The Church defines this as one meal a day, and two smaller meals which if added together would not exceed the main meal in quantity.

Lenten Soup Suppers Join us for a Lenten Experience that will touch your lives and help prepare your hearts for journeying with Christ toward the joy of Easter. Each evening begins with Mass at 4:00 PM in the Basilica followed by soup supper and a short Lenten reflection. All are welcome...young and old alike.
