ST. ADALBERT OUR PATRON

Archbishop and missionary to the Poles, also called the "Apostle of Prussia." Born in 956 into a noble family in Bohemia, Adalbert studied with St. Adalbert of Magdeburg and received his name at confirmation, his own having been Wojtech. He was named the bishop of Prague in 982. His efforts to reform the clergy in Prague had made him many enemies. Pope John XV released him from his episcopal duties and he retired to a Benedictine Monastery in Rome. Duke Boleslav I of Poland and the citizens of Prague petitioned the pope for Adalbert's return to the city, and he once again took up his role as bishop. Unfortunately he was nevertheless expelled a second time and then returned to Rome. Then after a short ministry in Hungary, he went to preach the Good News to people living near the Baltic Sea. He and two companions were martyred by pagan priests in that region. Adalbert's body was immediately ransomed and buried in Gniezno Cathedral (Poland). In the mid-11th century his relics were moved to St. Vitus Cathedral in Prague.

Preaching the Good News can be dangerous work whether the audience is already baptized or not. Adalbert fearlessly preached Jesus' gospel and received a martyr's crown for his efforts.

Remember In Your Prayers...On the morning of April 10, 2010, members of Poland's military, political and church elite died in a plane crash in Russia. The Polish President, Lech Kaczynski, and 95 other dignitaries were traveling to a ceremony commemorating the 70th anniversary of the Katyn Forest Massacre, where 22,000 Polish officers were killed by Soviet secret police in one of Poland's

greatest national traumas. Remember in your prayers the family's affected by this tragedy and also the country of Poland.
