

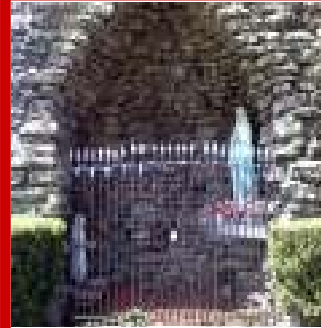

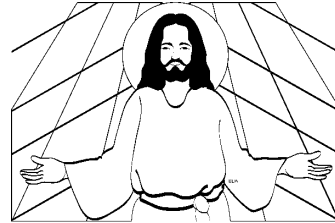

The Ascension of Our Lord, which occurred 40 days after Jesus Christ rose from the dead on Easter Sunday, is the final act of our redemption that Christ began on Good Friday. On this day, the risen Christ, in the sight of His apostles, ascended bodily into Heaven. (Luke 24:51; Mark 16:19; Acts 1:9-11).



The resurrection of Christ is the foundation of our faith. Christ's bodily Ascension foreshadows our own entrance into Heaven not simply as souls, after our death, but as glorified bodies, after the resurrection of the dead at the Final Judgment.

"He ascended into heaven, sits at the right hand of God the Father" - The Apostles Creed.

History of Our Grotto The Grotto of the Immaculate Conception adjacent to the Basilica was constructed during the Pastorate of Fr. Flaczek, around 1901. It is a close replica of the original grotto in Lourdes, France and even contains similar stones. For many years it was common to see parishioners and visitors kneeling at the grotto, placing their petitions before the Blessed Mother. They would often leave flowers at the grotto when their prayers were answered.
