HAPPY VALENTINES DAY! There are some 40 saints named Valentine, but the one to be most famous was (d. 269) the Roman priest, physician, and martyr. He was executed on February 14th, during the reign of Emperor Claudius II Gothicus, and was buried on the Via Flaminia. In 350, a basilica was erected on the spot of his burial. On his feast day, the custom of sending "Valentines" is celebrated, and given to a loved one; the custom stems from the medieval belief that birds choose their mates on this day. Valentine is thus the patron saint of lovers. Feast Day: February 14th (Taken from Our Sunday Visitor's Encyclopedia of Saints)
